Eligibility

The Scholarship Fund is open to students who regularly attend Evangelical Free Church of Pullman. Children of missionaries supported by the Evangelical Free Church of Pullman who do not attend the church due to proximity are also eligible by extension. Applicants must be high school seniors or have successfully completed at least one semester of on-campus or long distance college courses and who wish to attend college or other continuing higher education institutions.

Requirements

On a separate sheet of paper, please complete and attach the following:

- ◆ A statement of faith (testimony).
- ◆ An explanation of your reason for applying, including your financial need and why you should be considered for this scholarship (essay).
- ◆ A description of your involvement with the Evangelical Free Church of Pullman.
- ◆ Two letters of recommendation. One from an individual associated with the Evangelical Free Church of Pullman and one from another source (teacher, professor, pastor, coach, etc.)
- ◆ A copy of scores from your GPA, SAT or ACT tests, as applicable.

- ◆ Financial need disclosure form. MUST be submitted in a sealed envelope separate from the rest of the application.
- ◆ Applications will be scored based on statement of faith, explanation of reason for applying (essay), description of involvement with the Evangelical Free church of Pullman, and letters of recommendation. Preference will be given to applicants who have exhibited strong academic and extracurricular achievement while serving the body through their work at the Evangelical Free Church of Pullman or on the mission field. The sealed financial disclosure will be opened and used only in the event the scholarship committee needs a tiebreaker between two or more candidates.

Additional Information

Students may apply for a scholarship every year. If awarded funds, you will be contacted for the necessary information to send the funds to the academic institution of your choice. (Funds are not released directly to an applicant.) If the academic institution will match funds, you will be required to provide E-Free with complete information on this opportunity.

Distribution of funds will be as follows:

- ◆ High school seniors will receive funds at the beginning of the second semester/quarter.
- ◆ Second semester/quarter students, sophomores, juniors, seniors, and those attending higher education institutions will have the funds dispersed at the beginning of the fall semester/quarter.
- ◆ Funds will be released to the school and not the applicant.
- ◆ The amount of any award(s) is at the discretion of the committee.

Deadlines set for applications are as follows:

- ◆ February 21: applications are available on request.
- ◆ March 21: completed applications must be received and dated by the church office.
- ◆ April 10: applicants will be notified of the results of the Scholarship Committee.

Other important items:

- ◆ Late applications WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED
- ◆ Hard copies only. Due to the confidential nature of some application items, electronic copies will not be accepted.
- ◆ An email confirmation will be sent on March 22nd to all applicants notifying the receipt of complete applications. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE AN EMAIL OF CONFIRMATION on March 22nd, you must contact the church office by March 26th to check on your application status or it will not be considered.
